= 2 points.



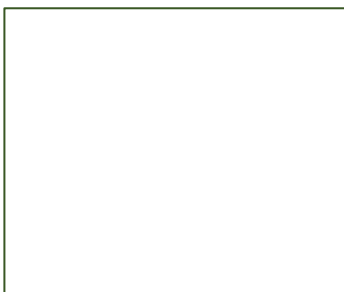
Can you find a bright yellow flower? Can you name it?
