Can you make a rainbow using different coloured leaves?  
= 1 point.



How many different types of nuts can you find?  
= 1 point per nut species (maximum of 3).



Can you find a red berry, a black berry, and an orange berry? Best not to touch them, they might be poisonous!  
= 3 points.



Can you find a nice dry hole a bird could roost in at night? = 1 point.



Can you find a deep pile of dry leaves that might make a nice nest for a mouse or hedgehog? = 1 point.



How many different bird sounds can you hear?  
= 1 point.



Can you find three acorns?  
= 1 point.



Can you find a tree that has rough bark that lots of insects could spend the winter in? Can you name the tree for an extra point? = 2 points.



Can you find three different sets of footprints in the mud and identify who made them? = 3 points.



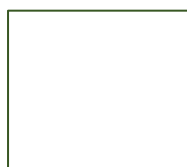
Can you find a path through the wood that has been made by an animal? What was the animal? = 2 points.



Can you find some old man's beard growing in a tree? It's a type of lichen with long strands. = 1 point.



Can you find witches' broom in a birch tree? = 1 point.
